

FIGURE SKATING SILVER IN 1971

Prince Edward Island's first figure skating medal came in the 1971 Canada Winter Games in Saskatoon. The team of Hal Constable and Gladys Gallant won silver in the Dance Class "B" event. The team of Sheldon Page and Jane Clarke of Alberta won the gold. Ontario's duo of Taylor & Thompson took home the bronze.

Team PEI captured the Centennial Cup for the most improved team at the 1971 Games. It's the only time the Island has won that distinction.
